Writing a book report

Body	
<p>Theme is the main idea of the story. Some examples might be the importance of friendship or how to be courageous in a difficult situation</p>	
<p>Setting is the time and place of the story. Is it set a long time ago or now. Does it take place in another country or in an imaginary place?</p>	
<p>Plot is what happens. You want to tell what the story is mostly about. What is the main event or conflict? What things lead up to it? What happens as a result?</p>	
<p>Characters</p>	
<p>The Main Character is called the protagonist. Who is it in your book?</p>	
<p>Do the other characters help or hinder the main character?</p>	

Writing a book report

Once you have summarized the book, you can tell what you think about it. You can write about whatever opinions you have. Some questions you might want to answer are:

What was the best part of the book?

How did the story make you feel?

Did you feel different things at different points in the story?
